4. **Candidates whose 10+2 examination is due in March-April 2023 are also eligible to apply for CUET-2023. However, they are required to have fulfilled the eligibility criteria at the time of admission.**

1. From the above subjects / languages, the candidate can choose maximum of 10 subjects from all three Section as given in Annexure 1.		
2. Examination will be conducted on multiple days in three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.		

Important Instructions:

- Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) - 2023 through the “Online” mode only on the website <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> . Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
