- 4. Candidates whose 10+2 examination is due in March-April 2023 are also eligible to apply for CUET-2023. However, they are required to have fulfilled the eligibility criteria at the time of admission.

- ii. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/ . Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv.
