#### B. Guidelines and Selection Procedure PG (Lateral Entry) Programmes.

- 1. Candidates are advised to go through the detailed admission notification thoroughly and **check eligibility required for each programme** before submitting the online application form for admission and follow the instructions, available on the website, carefully before filling-up the relevant fields/columns of the application form.
- 2. All programmes are full-time regular courses for the specified duration.
- 3. Candidates are required to submit online application forms, available on the university website www.cusrinagar.edu.in and upload Transcript/Grade Card of 1st, 2nd& 3rd Years of Bachelor's degree revealing cumulative grade point average (CGPA)/ percentage.
- 4. Candidates applying under any reserved category are required to upload self-attested photocopy of reserved category.
- 5. The selection of candidates for admission to each programme shall be made strictly on the basis of the aggregate academic merit obtained by the candidate in bachelor's degree.
- 6. A candidate has to deposit online non-refundable application fee of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred Only).
- 7. The selection of candidate for admission in each programme shall be made strictly on the basis of eligibility required for each programme specified above and aggregate academic merit of bachelor's degree obtained by the candidate. Application Form shall be rejected if candidate fails to prove his/her eligibility and fails to upload the required documents.
- 8. Mere submission of application form by the candidate does not confer his/her any right to admission in any programme of the university. Admission of candidates shall be governed by the Admission Policy of the university.
- 9. Admission Committee of each constituent college will check/verify the original copies of educational/category certificates etc. of the candidate at the time of admission and it will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to satisfy whether he/she is meeting the prescribed criteria.
- 10. Admission/Selection of the candidate shall be strictly provisional and subject to verification of documents, made at any point of time during/after the admission process. The admission will be rejected if the applicant does not fulfill the eligibility criteria or has misrepresented/suppressed the information regarding category and other details.

- 11. Reservation of seats for admission to various programmes shall be as per S.O. 127 dated: 20-04-2020 read with S.O. 249 dated: 23-07-2021.No under process reserve category certificate shall be accepted at any cost.
- 12. For Admission under Self-Financed Quota, selection of the candidates shall be made strictly on the basis of the aggregate academic merit obtained by the candidate in bachelor's degree for which a separate notification shall be issued by the university.
- 13. Candidates of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester of Batch 2019, belonging to Cluster University Srinagar whose results are awaited can also apply provisionally. However they will update their marks online as and when their result are declared by the university for which link shall be made live.
- 14. Candidates who apply under any reserved category are required to submit Self-Attested photocopy of Reserved Category Certificate along with Hard-Copy of Application Form and other necessary documents at Cluster University Srinagar Gogji-Bagh Srinagar.
- 15. Candidates are advised to remain in touch with the university website for all the updates regarding admission related information. No separate correspondence shall be made by the university to any candidate.
