As per the directions from Regional Director NSS , New Delhi and instructions passed on by NSS cell of Cluster University Srinagar , NSS units of various constituent and affiliated colleges of Cluster University Srinagar organized and celebrated the National Youth Day in a befitting manner .

## 1 GCW, M.A Road Srinagar .

NSS wing of GCW M.A. Road Srinagar, under the guidance of worthy Principal Dr. Yasmeen Farooq organized a one-day **Round Table Conference** under theme **Role of Youth in Viksit Jammu and Kashmir**, in collaboration with **Think India, Srinagar** in the college conference hall. 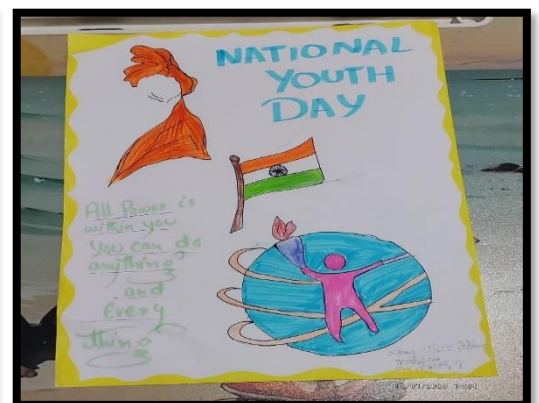
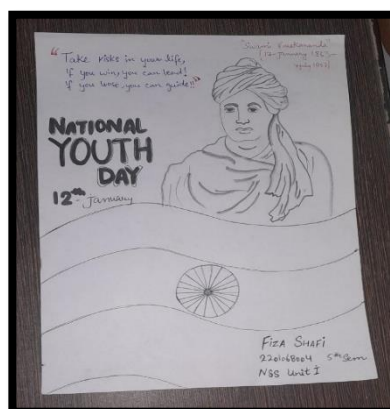
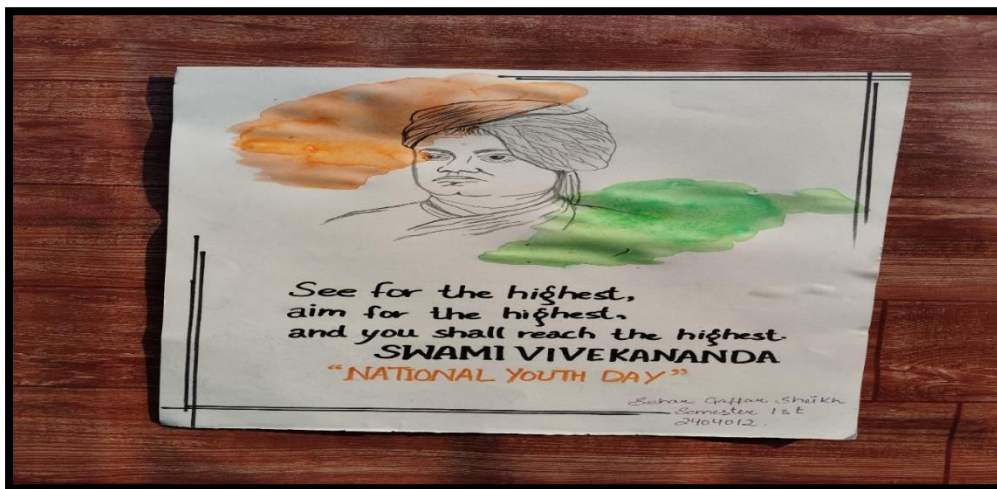
## 5. S.P College , M.A Road
